The Mary C. Dyster Women's Pavilion

At Niagara Falls Memorial Medical Center, we recognize that women have unique healthcare needs.

Our Mary C. Dyster Women's Pavilion is designed to meet those needs. The pavilion's maternity unit occupies the entire second floor and features:

- Private homelike accommodations for labor, delivery and recovery with shower, rocking chair, bassinets and cable TV
- "Rooming-in" for newborns to enhance family bonding
- Visiting hours: Noon to 8:30 p.m.
- Brothers and sisters of newborns may visit by appointment (must be age 2 or older)



Childbirth Classes

Memorial offers free prenatal classes to prepare expectant parents for childbirth and parenting.

Classes are held in the Community Education Room on the third floor of the Mary C. Dyster Women's Pavilion.

Classes cover the following topics:

- Coping with the minor discomforts of pregnancy
- Understanding labor and delivery
- Cesarean birth
- Postpartum recovery
- Caring for your newborn

Classes will tour the state-of-the-art maternity unit in the Dyster Pavilion.
